Birdies for the Brave Patriots' Outpost Presented by Lockheed Martin 2010 WGC-CA Championship

- WHEN:** Wednesday, March 10, 2010 – Sunday, March 14, 2010
- WHERE:** The Patriots' Outpost Presented by Lockheed Martin will offer panoramic views of the 17th green during the World Golf Championships – CA Championship at the Doral Golf Resort & Spa, a Marriott Resort. The Outpost is ideally located at the pivotal 17th hole before players must face the daunting 18th hole which ranked as the second hardest hole on the PGA TOUR in 2009. This location ensures exciting golf action and easy access to the rest of the course.
- WHAT:** The Patriots' Outpost Presented by Lockheed Martin is an expansive military hospitality chalet designed exclusively for military men and women and their families. Active duty and Retired members of the military from all five branches and the National Guard along with their dependents are invited to attend the tournament free of charge simply by showing their military ID at the entrance gate. Once inside, they are invited to visit the Patriots' Outpost on a complimentary basis from Wednesday, March 10 through Sunday, March 14. The Patriots' Outpost will provide military guests with complimentary food and beverage, television coverage of competition each day, and interactive activities provided by Lockheed Martin and their sub-contractors.
- The Patriots' Outpost Presented by Lockheed Martin is part of the PGA TOUR's national Birdies for the Brave military outreach program. In addition to raising funds for military men and women and their families through charity golf events hosted throughout the year at the TOUR's TPC clubs, Birdies for the Brave includes military appreciation celebrations held during PGA TOUR tournaments; postcard and letter-writing campaigns for the troops; donation drives for military families; and the Adopt-A-Wounded Warrior Program – a collaborative effort with the Wounded Warrior Project in which honorary TPC club memberships are awarded to local wounded warriors to aid in the rehabilitation process and show appreciation for their service to our country.

- On Thursday, March 11, The WGC-CA Championship will host Military Appreciation Day. Military Appreciation ceremonies will commence at 10:00AM on the 1st Tee of TPC Blue Monster followed by a reception in the Patriots' Outpost. All media are invited to attend.
